Job Summary

The Assistant Golf Course Superintendent will assist the superintendent in the management and maintenance of the golf course and facilities, overseeing staff, irrigation, turf care, and ensuring high standards of course playability.

Key Responsibilities

Maintenance Oversight: Assist the Golf Course Superintendent in managing the daily operations of the golf course, including the maintenance of greens, fairways, and other areas to ensure optimal conditions for play.

Performs the implementation of an overall turf health program. This includes aeration, topdressing and the application of pesticides, fertilizer and chemicals to the golf course turf.

Operates an assortment of golf course equipment, including but not limited to: mowers, utility vehicles, sweepers, brooms, rollers, rakes, sprayers, loaders, compressors, trenchers, automobiles, etc.

Staff Management: Supervise and train new ground crew members, ensuring they understand their roles and responsibilities.

Irrigation and Turf Management: Manage irrigation systems and oversee turf maintenance practices, including mowing, fertilization, and pest control.

Safety Compliance: Enforce safety standards and ensure compliance with local, state, and federal regulations regarding pesticide application and equipment.

Budget: Help prepare and manage the operating budget, keeping track of supplies and equipment maintenance.

Communications: Interact with members and address their concerns regarding course conditions, ensuring a high level of customer satisfaction.

Qualifications

- Experience and knowledge of management and maintenance of greens, tee boxes, fairways, and roughs.
- Ability to both operate and do maintenance and repairs on standard equipment and tools used in golf course maintenance.
- Knowledge of safe use, mixing and application of chemicals and commercial products.
- Possession of a Pesticide Applicators License and Aquatic Certification or in the process of obtaining them within 6 months.
- Experience in operating, as well as the basic repair, of a course irrigation system.
- Minimum of two-year degree or certificate in turf management.
- Ability and passion to build a team and promote positive relations with members and staff.
- Ability to organize and prioritize work to meet required deadlines.
- Ability to work irregular hours and weekends during the golf season (Apr. 1 to Oct. 31) and regular hours during off season (Nov. 1 to Mar. 31).
