Operates and maintains drainage, irrigation and watering systems. Supervises staff in proper and safe operation and maintenance of equipment. Plans and budgets for additional or replacement capital equipment. Assist with snow removal planning. Establish short- and long-range plans for the golf course. Creates and maintains records of course maintenance and projects. Prepare annual operating budget for department. Creates capital improvement budget. Manages monthly expenses including payroll, supplies, chemicals, and fertilizers to align with budget. Attends and contributes at monthly management meeting. Attends educational programs to maintain current knowledge of technical and turf innovations. Communicates with members, employees, managers, and general manager about current and future maintenance activities. Plans professional development and training activities for department including safety training for equipment use, proper handling of fertilizers, herbicides and all other chemicals used on course. Conducts monthly safety meetings in accordance with OSHA rules and regulations. Hires, schedules, trains, supervises, and evaluates all department personnel.
